Duck Delivery Market Updates

Week of: 01/11/19

Apples: The market is steady. Quality is excellent.

Asparagus: Market is high. The market is up and expected to be up through January. Quality is good.

Avocado: Market is escalated. Tighter supplies out of Mexico are causing this market to rise. Quality is good.

Bananas: Market is steady.

Beans, green: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Berries: Blackberries: market is higher due to cold weather in growing areas. Quality is good. Blueberries: market is steady. Chilean fruit is here with good quality. Raspberries: market is higher due to cold weather in growing areas. Quality is good. Strawberries: market is high. Weather and growing transitions are still having an effect on the berry fields causing higher than normal pricing. Quality is fair.

Broccoli: Market is high. With the cold weather, this market has tightened up and has limited supplies going into next week. Quality is fair to good.

Brussels sprouts: Market is higher. The recent cold weather has had an effect on this market making supplies tight going into next week. Quality is fair.

Cabbage: Market is up on red and green. Good quality.

Carrots: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Cauliflower: Market is high. We will likely see this market continue to remain high for the next week or two due to the cold weather. Quality is fair.

Celery: Market is high. Supplies are still tight and the freezing weather will not help the situation, expect higher pricing and lower quality in the next 7-10 days. Quality is fair.

Cilantro: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Citrus: Lemon market is steady, with good quality. Limes are expected to go up in price with tighter supplies. Navel oranges are steady with good quality.

Corn: Market is steady. We are seeing a steady supply out of Florida with good quality.

Cucumbers: Market is higher. The cold weather has affected this market as well causing tighter supplies. Quality is good.

Eggplant: Market is higher. Cold weather has slowed production and prices will remain higher through next week. Good quality.

Fennel/anise: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Grapes: Market is steady. Green grapes have good supply with good quality. Red grapes have good supply, good quality. Off shore fruit for both colors are here.

Kale: Market is escalated. Cooler weather in Yuma has slowed down production. Quality is good.

Lettuce, iceberg: Market is higher. The freezing weather in Yuma has caused a spike in this market also affecting quality. You are likely to see epidermal blistering and peeling. Quality is fair.

Lettuce, leaf: Market is higher. Freezing weather in the last week has caused significant damage to the lettuce markets. All romaine and leaf items are seeing blistering and peeling with lower yields. Green and red leaf markets are higher as well with fair quality.

Melons: Market is higher. Cantaloupes are a bit higher this week with good quality. Honeydew markets are higher with good quality. Watermelons are gapping and are seeing higher prices due to weather in Mexico.

Onions, green: Market is higher. Weather has created lighter volume and slowed production. Quality is fair.

Onions, red/yellow: Markets are climbing with good supplies on hand, but as growers switch to storage crops, prices will go up. Quality is good.

Pears: Market is steady. Good sugar levels with great quality.

Peas, sugar/snap: Market is higher. Snap peas are tight in supply. Snow peas are steady, but not a lot of volume available.

Peppers: The green pepper market is higher with fair quality due to the freezing weather in Mexico. Both red and yellow bell peppers are both tight in supply and high in price due to

cooler weather. Chile peppers are also in high demand with a limited supply due to wet/cold weather which will likely continue through January.

Pineapples: Market remains steady with fruit out of all growing regions. Quality is good.

Potatoes, baker: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Potatoes, colored: Market is steady. The NW growing regions have plenty of supply with great quality.

Spinach: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Squash: Market is higher. Both yellow and zucchini are seeing increasing prices due to cold weather. Quality is good.

Tomato, cherry: Market is higher. Quality is fair.

Tomato, grape: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Tomato, romas: Market is higher. Cold weather is causing fruit to come in green with higher prices. Quality is fair.

Tomato, rounds: Market is escalated. This market isn't changing as fast as we thought it would. Supplies are still tight and aren't expected to change much in the next week. Quality is good.
