Apples: The market is steady. Quality is excellent.

Asparagus: Market is steady. We should see some new crop 28# cases the second week of February. Quality is good.

Avocado: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Bananas: Market is steady.

Beans, green: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Berries: Blackberries: market is steady. Quality is good. Blueberries: market is steady. Chilean fruit is here with good quality. Raspberries: market is steady. Quality is good. Strawberries: market is high. California has had some wet weather that is not helping in growth and color, but warmer weather is expected which should help. Quality is fair.

Broccoli: Market is steady. The warmer weather has helped growth and increasing supply. Quality is fair to good.

Brussels sprouts: Market is higher. The recent cold weather has had an effect on this market making supplies tight. Quality is fair.

Cabbage: Market is steady on red and green. Good quality.

Carrots: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Cauliflower: Market is steady. There is a market gap expected the week of 2/10, which will increase the prices. Quality is good.

Celery: Market is high. Supplies are still tight and the cold weather has had effects on quality. Quality is fair.

Cilantro: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Citrus: Lemon market is steady, with good quality. Limes are steady with more volume expected. Navel oranges are steady with good quality.

Corn: Market is higher. We are seeing a steady supply out of Florida with good quality.

Cucumbers: Market is lower. We are seeing more volume after the cold weather in Mexico slowed production for a couple of weeks. Quality is good.

Eggplant: Market is lower. Good quality.

Fennel/anise: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Grapes: Market is higher. Grapes out of Chile & Peru are tight in supply causing higher prices. Expect to see better pricing and availability by early February.

Kale: Market is high. This market is active and tight. Quality is good.

Lettuce, iceberg: Market is steady. Demand has been high and volume has been good with prices starting to settle. Quality is fair.

Lettuce, leaf: Market is steady. The lettuce markets continue to improve with better weather. Romaine and romaine hearts are in much better supply with fair quality. Green and red leaf markets are steady as well with fair quality.

Melons: Market is steady. Cantaloupes are seeing increasing offshore volumes with good quality. Honeydew markets are higher with good quality. Watermelons are seeing higher prices due to weather in Mexico.

Onions, green: Market is high. Weather has created lighter volume and slowed production. Quality is fair.

Onions, red/yellow: Markets are climbing with good supplies on hand, but as growers switch to storage crops, prices will go up until new crop out of Mexico starts. Quality is good.

Pears: Market is steady. Good sugar levels with great quality.

Peas, sugar/snap: Market is steady. Quality is good.

Peppers: The green pepper market is steady. We are seeing improvements in supply out of Mexico with fair quality. Both red and yellow bell peppers are loosening up with more volume available. Chile peppers are starting to loosen up in a small, slow way.

Pineapples: Market remains steady with fruit out of all growing regions. Quality is good.

Potatoes, baker: Market is higher. Quality is good.
